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Designated Task Force Sites

The responsibility of each Site is to provide *no less than five (5) days or a minimum of thirty (30) hours of intensive professional development*, in order to meet the specifications of being a designated site. The 5 days or 30 hours may be configured in such a manner that they meet the needs of the Site, the educators, the community that is being served, and the Task Force. Sites prepare and coordinate the delivery of professional development activities designed to provide a replicable instructional program to ensure consistency of learning among teachers and subsequently their students.
